Guidelines for Grant Requests

The Thornton Tomasetti Foundation accepts proposals from individuals who represent organizations wishing to fund activities that support the [mission of the foundation](#). Students seeking support for education costs should work through the dean at their college or university. The Foundation does not accept requests from individual students.

For organizations seeking project funding support, please email your request (on your organization letterhead) to info@ThorntonTomasettiFoundation.org. The letter should follow this outline:

- 1) 150 words: The function and mission of your organization
- 2) 300 words: how you will use the money
- 3) 150 words: approx project schedule
- 4) 200 words: key benefits afforded by the project and how those benefits will be measured
- 5) List of other contributors you have obtained commitments from, or plan to approach
- 6) 100 words each: profiles of key project leader(s)
- 7) 100 words: How will lessons learned be generalized for application to other areas?

The Foundation has a rolling grant schedule and considers grant applications as they are received. We will confirm receipt of your application and at that time give you an approximate time for a decision.
