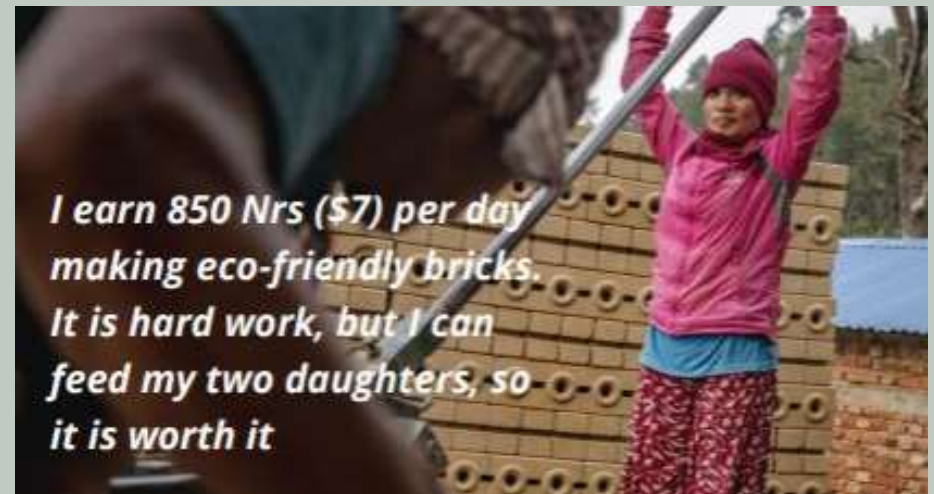

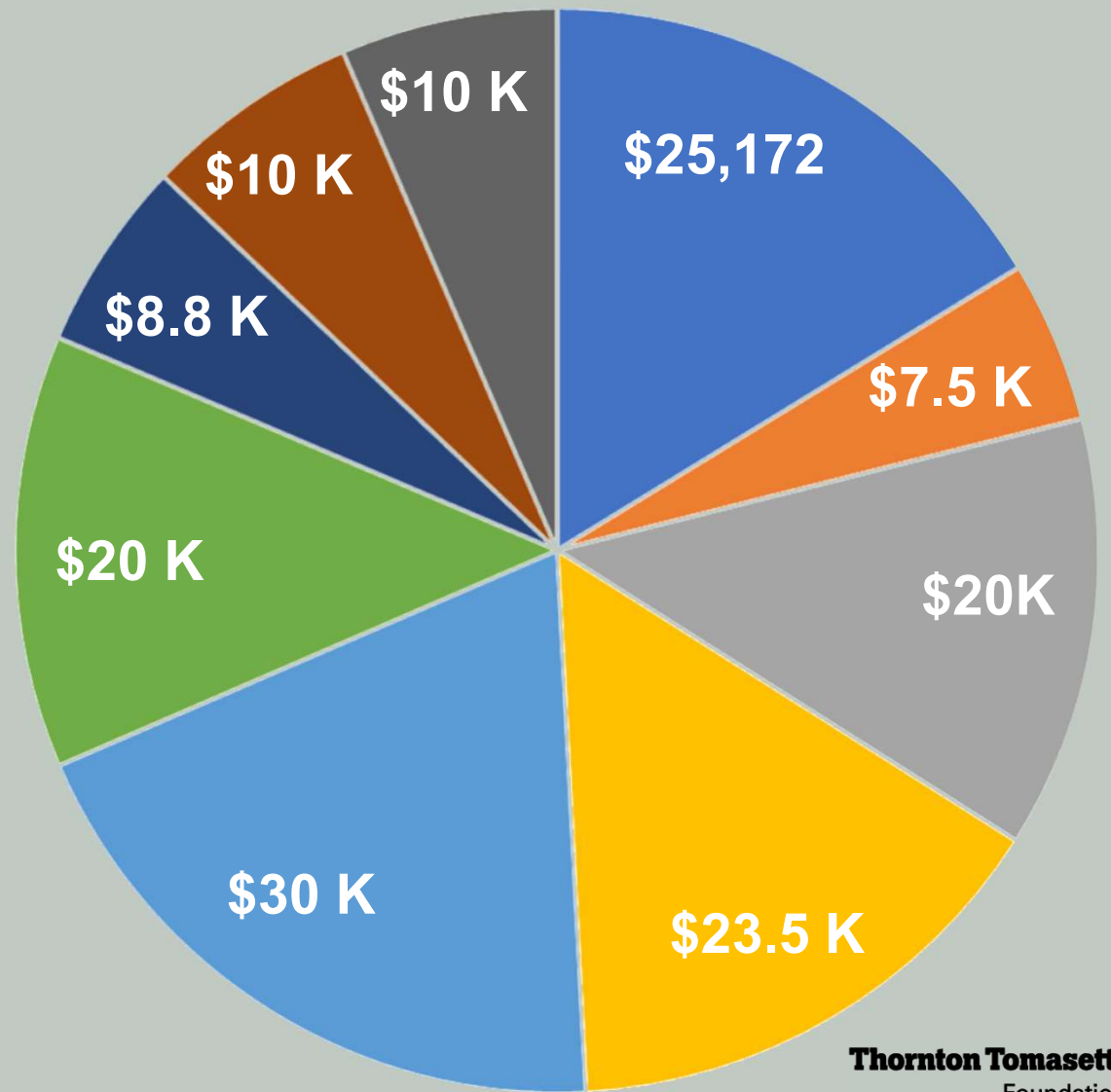
Technical Literacy Fellowship

- Award Student Scholarships
- Award out first ever scholarship in the UK
 - Working with the Institute of Civil Engineers (ICE), the Foundation will award a Queen's Jubilee Scholarship Trust (QUEST) undergraduate scholarship
